The Chakra Collection >

The Chakra Collection are hand-crafted 24k. gold repoussé. Each amulet incorporates precious stones according to Vedic tradition with the vibration that is appropriate to the chakra it corresponds to.

These finely made amulets come without the chain. They have an adjustable clasp, which enables the wearer to attach them to the chain of their choice. You can mix them up and wear more than one at a time as charms on a necklace or a bracelet. They can also be ordered as earrings.

Chakra amulets made from 24k. hammered gold and precious stones (ruby, coral, yellow sapphire, emerald, turquoise, blue sapphire and rough cut diamond, white topaz)

Buddha Amulet

24k. hammered gold with Burmese ruby. Adjustable clasp. Approx. 1". Chain sold separately. Item# TG-028

A Buddha is a being who has become fully awakened or enlightened and has achieved Nirvana, or complete liberation from suffering and the bonds of Maya. Buddha literally means "awakened one" or "he/she who has become aware."



HRIM Amulet

24k. hammered gold with Indian rough cut diamond. Adjustable clasp approx. 5/8" Chain sold separately. Item# TG-032

Also called the Devi Pranav—the equivalent of Om— Hrim refers to the heart (Hridaya).

The mantra Hrim is the pure sound emanating from the union of the male and female principles— the sound of Siva- Shakti. In Vedic terms HRIM is a mantra of the Sun and embodies divine illumination and light. In addition, Hrim is the main mantra of the Sri Yantra, the ultimate manifestation of the Goddess. While awakening us at a soul level, HRIM opens our hearts to enlightenment, transformation and purification.



OM Amulet

24k. hammered gold with Indian rough cut diamond. Adjustable clasp approx. 5/8" Chain sold separately. Item# TG-027

Om is the most sacred syllable in Hinduism, symbolizing the entire Universe. This syllable is also known as the primordial mantra, because it is considered to be the primal sound and to have ushered in the beginning of creation.

OM is the goal which yogis desire to reach. The syllable itself is considered Brahman, or the highest. The Vedas state "Whosoever knows this symbol obtains all that he desires. This is the best and highest support."

24k gold, finely hand crafted repoussé. With rough cut diamond or ruby.



The Sahashara

The Crown Chakra or "thousand petal lotus" is the chakra at the top of the head. Wisdom, understanding, spiritual connection and bliss flow down through this chakra.

This chakra is beyond the elements.

The Sahashara contains every color— the stone used is rough-cut diamond or white topaz.

This mantra is beyond sound.

The Ajana

This chakra is the Third Eye. The Ajana allows us to see the big picture and is a window to cosmic Knowledge.

The color of the Ajana is indigo, the stone used is blue sapphire.

Its mantra—inscribed on the back side of the amulet— is OM

The Visudda

The Throat Chakra rules creativity, communication and growth (in this case, growth as a form of expression). Its name means "Pure."

The color of the Visudda is blue, the stone used is turquoise.

Its mantra—inscribed on the back side of the amulet— is HUM

The Anahatha

The Anahatha is the Heart Chakra. Its power is the innate knowledge of unity, devotion and universal Love.

The color of the Anahatha is green or pink, the stones used are ruby or emerald.

Its mantra—inscribed on the back side of the amulet— side of your amulet is YAM

The Manipuraka

"Jewel of the lotus" or "lustrous gem" are names for this chakra, the Navel Chakra. It relates to the pure expression of one's unique individuality in the physical world.

The color of the Manipuraka is yellow, and the stone used in this amulet is yellow sapphire.

Its mantra—inscribed on the back side of the amulet— is RAM

The Swadisthana

This chakra— the Sex Chakra, connects us to others through feeling, desire, sensation and movement. Its name means "abode of the Vital Force" or "dwelling place of the Self."

The color of the Swadisthana is orange, and the stone used in this amulet is coral

Its mantra—inscribed on the back side of the amulet— is VAM

The Muladhara

The Muladhara is also known as the Root Chakra. It is the seat of Kundalini and is located at the base of the spine. The power of this Chakra establishes us in earthly experience.

The color of the Muladhara is red, and the stone used in this amulet is ruby.

Its mantra—inscribed on the back side of the amulet— is LAM

Gemstone Vibrational Qualities

Gems have long been believed to contain healing properties and powers of protection. Each gemstone has a particular vibration, which creates a magnetic energy field that protects, balances and empowers the wearer. Wearing the right gemstone can bring an increased sense of vitality, inner strength and clarity.

Blue Sapphire

A serene stone, the blue sapphire is helpful in meditations, and in aligning the mental, physical, and spiritual planes. This magical stone enhances psychic ability and is considered a guardian of love—promoting harmony within and between friends and lovers.

Coral

Acts as an aid for meditation and visualization, and is an agent of inner change and dispeller of negative emotions. Coral represents the energy of life force. It is especially beneficial in supporting the sexual/creative chakra.

Diamonds

Radiating purity and indestructibility, diamonds symbolize the central sun within us and the perfection of our Higher Selves. Diamonds aid in trust, confidence and purification. Because they flash all colors, they can help us to align with the Universal All.

Emeralds provide inspiration and aid us in cultivating patience and achieving balance within. Emeralds support us in our meditation and healing work. Wearing this stone has the effect of increasing our sensitivity on the psychic planes as its vibration acts upon us naturally in refining our consciousness. Traditionally, emeralds were treasured as talismans because of their protective qualities.

Pearls

As a symbol of the ultimate feminine energy, pearls act as a clear conduit to the universal Goddess. The calming and centering vibration of the pearl enhances personal integrity and purifies the mind so that it can be an open channel for wisdom and spiritual guidance. These Moon and water ruled "gems" enhance sincerity, truth and loyalty and bring calming reflection and inner peace.

Ruby

The stone of passion, its energy is that of the compassionate heart. Brings spiritual balance, confidence, flexibility, vitality, devotion, prosperity and leadership. Ruby acts as a catalyst for the stimulation of Kundalini energy located at the base of the spine.

Rudrani

Thought of as the female counterpart to the male Rudraksha seed, the rare and precious Rudrani is a sacred seed born of the Rudraksha tree. When the tree is in full blossom the Rudrani seeds are shed from its blossoms and collected for their blessings.

In India the Rudrani is often kept in places of worship alongside the Rudraksha to symbolize the union of Siva and Shakti—the divine meeting of male and female principles.

Turquoise

Sacred to both Native American and ancient Asian traditions, this stone helps us to connect with Spirit and brings the energy of the sky down to earth. While moving the wearer towards integration and wholeness, it grounds us in an expanding awareness. In ancient times, turquoise was utilized to gain wealth.

White Topaz

Increases awareness of thoughts and deeds and the karmic effects of same. White topaz purifies emotions and actions while activating cosmic consciousness. It is especially beneficial in supporting the Third eye, Crown and etheric chakras (above the head).

Yellow Sapphire

Like the God it symbolizes, Ganesha—the Hindu God of wealth and remover of obstacles—the yellow sapphire bestows its wearer with abundance, wellness, recognition and success. It gives us increased ability to persevere, while it enhances our self-confidence and trust in the Universe.

Gold

Intimately linked with Divinity and with those gods associated with the Sun. Gold is the material of choice in ancient times for fashioning sacred images and for magical rituals. It symbolizes wisdom, wealth and success. Gold has protective powers and enhances personal power. It promotes courage, confidence and willpower.

The Technique

Repoussé is a metal working technique where flat sheets of metal are crafted into three-dimensional images by using chisels of various shapes and sizes. It is a laborious art form that requires great patience to master and tremendous skill to execute with refinement. The variations in texture and small surface "imperfections" are evidence of the chisel and hammer work and are hallmarks of repoussé. Though it is rarely practiced in our contemporary world, within the Newar community in Nepal it is a tradition that is passed down over generations from father to son. Tulku works with these master craftsmen to bring this ancient art to the new world.

All the Tulku gold pieces are hand-crafted with care and devotion in Kathmandu, Nepal. The repoussé amulets are original works of art made by a Newar Buddhist priest and blessed by his pure connection to Spirit.

Tulku

"The form body of a Buddha"

In the Tibetan tradition, a tulku is the recognized reincarnation of a past Buddhist master. The new incarnation takes rebirth to bring blessings and benefit to all sentient beings.

Tulku Jewels, like the name they embody, represent the rebirth of spirit into a new form. They are tools to remind us of our divine nature which is unbounded by time or space.

Karla Refojo, the creator of Tulku, is a painter, sculptor and meditator. She travels regularly to Nepal where she works with Newar and Tibetan master craftsmen to broaden her knowledge and connection with the source of her inspiration.
